Katherine Andrews, founder of the Animal Psychology Center, specializes in putting people and their dogs in communication.

“What that means is that the bad or unwanted behavior will be replaced by good or healthy habits,” she said. “The ‘fix’ involves both you and your dog... although I will admit that many times it is more you!”

Katherine’s natural ability to communicate with animals was evident early in her life. She spent much of her childhood in the



forrest befriending animals much like Jane Goodall. As a young adult she founded and was Director of a Humane Society in Dallas, Texas. This large facility on 10 acres gave her the opportunity to rescue and rehabilitate hundreds of dogs, cats and horses.
