Kathy Cline started her career in the word processing department of La-Z-Boy Chair Company in her hometown of Monroe, Michigan.

In 1974, she married someone who joined the Air Force to "see the world," but they were sent to Rapid City for four years. Kathy liked it so much she stayed here. She worked for the Institute of Atmospheric Sciences at the S.D. School of Mines and Technology for a year before she began her career as a legal secretary in 1976.

In 1985, she became a legal secretary to Federal Judge Richard Battey. In 1999, Judge Battey took senior status and Kathy was fortunate to be able to continue working for the new active judge, Judge Karen Schreier, also a Women's Network member.

"I am very fortunate because I enjoy both the work I do and the people I work with," Kathy says.

Kathy has been a member of NALS, the association for legal professionals, for more than 30 years and has earned certifications as a PLS . . . the advanced certification for the legal professional, as a Professional Paralegal (PP), and as a Certified Legal Assistant (CLA). She was selected by the Federal Judicial Center as a trainer for a program called "Maintaining Your Competitive Edge" for federal

judges' secretaries and traveled around the country for two years facilitating training courses.

Kathy strongly believes in continuing legal education for all legal staff and uses her time accordingly. She takes an active role in putting together seminars in Rapid City and across the state. From October to March of each year she has led local study groups for the different certification exams.



Kathy served on the Board of Directors at Arrowhead Country Club and was its first women president in 2002. She currently serves on the Golf Committee and on Arrowhead's Board of Trustees.

She married John Cline, a Rapid City native, in 1993. Their household includes two 6-year-old shetland sheepdogs, a sable named Kate and a blue merle named Lacey, and a 13-year-old silver Persian cat named Cinder.

Kathy and John play golf several times a week and compete in couples tournaments. They enjoy getting together casually with friends to have potlucks, play dominoes, and just visit. They like to go to movies. Kathy likes to read, spending most of this time on "escapism" in mysteries and legal-related crime dramas.

Several years ago Kathy instituted a winter "friendship brunch" to honor and say thanks to her close friends because friends are a very important part of life and we need to appreciate and take time for the ones we have.
